Reading

Maths

English – Writing Challenge

Imagine you are on a mission to an undiscovered planet. Write a diary outlining your experiences. You could write about the journey there and then landing on the planet or write your diary as if you are already on the planet doing jobs or exploring. It is up to you! When you are finished, you can upload your work to Seesaw.



Science – Space

Create a fact file about your favourite planet in our solar system. Make sure you include a lot of detail about the planet (average temperature, time to orbit the sun, etc.). If you want an extra challenge, you could research a planet outside of our solar system!



Art – Impressionism

Research an artist who followed the impressionist style. Look at some of their paintings and see if you can have a go at recreating them. You could use paint, or pencils, whichever medium suits you! Use the link below as a good starting point.
