Can your write about your favourite part of the story? Draw a picture to match your writing. <u>Science – Seasons</u> We will be learning about the different seasons this half term. What is your favourite season? Can you write about it and draw a picture? Can you create a piece of art work to show your favourite season? Get creative! What resources will you use? Challenge: Can you write a short poem about your favourite season?



<u>Art – Exploring lines</u>
