Reading

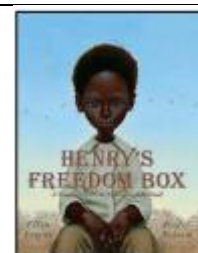
Children will get the opportunity to visit the library to choose a book to read. Please encourage your child to read a little each day.

Maths
