<u>Reading</u>

Maths

This half term we will be working with numbers from 20-50. *Can you write* your numbers from 20 to in the correct formation?




We will also be learning about partioning numbers. Pick some numners from 20-50. *Can you partition the numbers into tens and ones?* E.g. 23 has 2 tens and 3 ones How many numbers can you do this for?

We will be exploring mass and volume. Ask an adult for help to find objects around the house that are heavier and lighter than each other. Can you find objects that can float or sink in water? Can you use water to find how much water different bottles and containers can hold?
