English – Writing Challenge

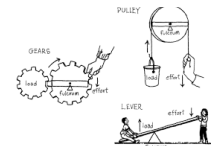
Write a recount of your summer holidays, or a recount of your dream summer holiday. Remember to use lots of description in your writing, make us feel like we were there with you!
