Reading

Maths

This half term we will be learning about place value of numbers to 20. **Can you count forwards and backwards from 0-10? Can you write your numbers in the correct order and correct formation?**

Write numbers 1-10 on pieces of paper, shuffle them and turn them over. Pick 3 numbers. **Can you put them in order smallest number to greatest?**

Use the cards again and pick 2 numbers. **Can you use these symbols to show which numbers are greater than, smaller than and equal to?** < > =

Eg: 3 > 2 8 < 10 9 = 9

English – Rapunzel

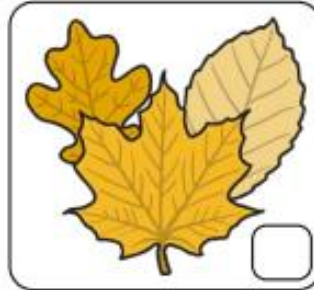

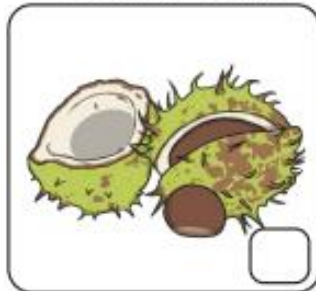

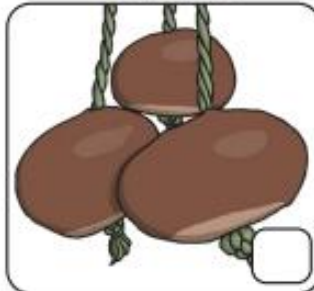

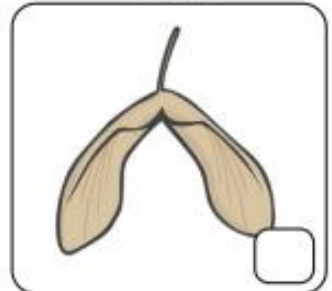
