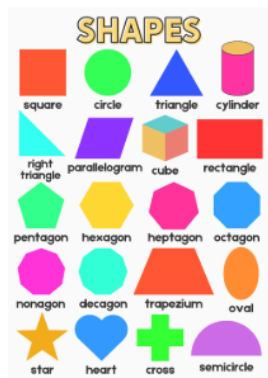
Spelling

Maths

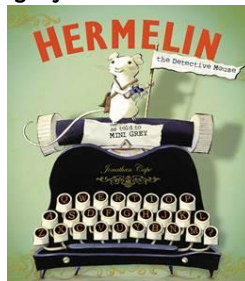
This half term we are learning about 2D and 3D shapes. **How many shapes can you name and draw? Do you know the names of the 3D shapes?**
