Spring 1



Reading

Please ensure that your child is reading as much as possible. Physical books are sent home on Friday to be returned the following **Wednesday**. A charge of £5 will be issued for any lost or damaged books.

Maths

This half term we will be looking at addition and subtraction within 20.

How many number bonds to 20 do you know? Can you complete fact families for them?

E.g. $12 + 8 = 20$

$8 + 12 = 20$

$20 - 12 = 8$

$20 - 8 = 12$

We will also be learning about length and height.

Can you find objects around the house that are the same height as you? Can you find objects around the house that are the same length as a shoe lace?

You can take pictures, draw and label objects or write a list.



English

This half term we will be reading the story of **Old Bear By Jane Hissey**

In the story Little Bear is lost in the attic. Let's pretend one of your toys is lost – oh no!

Can you write it a letter to find out where it's gone?

What questions could you ask your toy in the letter? Where is it? How does it feel? You could ask how it got lost...

You could draw them a nice picture, or a map of how to get home.

Remember how to set out a letter with *Dear...* and *From...*

Science

We will be learning about the different seasons and the changes they bring this half term.

Can you create a piece of artwork showcasing your favourite season? Why is it your favourite? What do you look forward to in that season? What do the trees and plants look like?

Be creative! See what materials you could use to make a wonderful display piece.



Art

This half term we will be exploring sculpture and 3D drawings.

Let's experiment with folding and rolling – how many ways can you fold or roll paper/newspaper? Can you combine these into a 3D paper creation?

You could also try doing observational drawings of 3D objects at home – try out different materials such as pencil, crayons, chalk, charcoal, paint...

Spellings
