Reading

Maths - Measurements

This half term we will be learning about measuring volume and mass.

Experiment with things you could find in the house to fill with water. Which holds the most? Which one holds the least? Which ones hold the same? Make a prediction!



Using some scales, have a go at weighing different things around the house. Can you find two things that weigh the same? Can you read the scales and record the weights of different things you find?



English – Where the Wild Things Are

This half term we will be reading the story of 'Where the Wild Things Are' by Maurice Sendak.

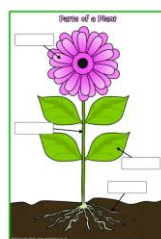
Can you write your own invitation to a wild rumpus? Draw how you would dress as a wild thing if you were joining in. Where would it be? What's the dress code? What would you eat?



Science – Plants

We will be learning about Plants this half term.

Can you make an instruction booklet/poster on how to care for a plant? What does it need? Can you label the parts of a plant?



What plants can you see at home or on the way to school? Do they look the same?

Geography – Weather

This half term we will be looking at the UK, and what the weather is like in the four seasons.

Try making a poster of the four seasons! What do you wear? What is the weather like? What symbols could you use to show the weather? What seasonal changes happen?



Can you keep a weather diary? Choose three colours (sunny, cloudy, rainy) and keep a log of what the weather is like that day (you could use a calendar). Which weather happens the most in the current season?
