Children will get the opportunity to visit the library to choose a book to read. Please encourage your child to read a little each day.

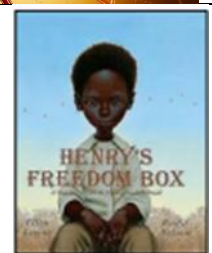


Maths

English – Henry's Freedom Box This half term, we are looking at biographies to inform the reader. We would like you to write a biography. You can write one about yourself (known as an autobiography) or pick a famous person to write one about. Remember to give lots of detail about key events from your chosen person's life.



Science – Living things and their habitats

Pick an animal from one of the classes of animals (e.g. mammals, birds, fish, reptiles, amphibians). Research the life cycle of your chosen animal and then create a poster or a presentation on the computer all about the life cycle of your chosen animal.



History - The Tudors

Was Henry VIII a good king or a bad one?

Create a poster/booklet answering the above question. Make sure you have evidence to back up your final decision. Tell us why you think he was a good or a bad king.
