### Reading

Please ensure that your child is reading as much as possible. Physical books are sent home on Friday to be returned the following Wednesday. A charge of £5 will be issued for any lost or damaged books.

### Maths

This half term we will be learning about **money** and **time**. The children will need to recognise the British pounds and pence, including notes by the end of Year 1. The children will also be learning to tell the time to O'clock and half past.



#### **Can you create your own moving clock?**

You can use a paper plate, card or paper.

You can use the sheet provided to tell the time. What time do you wake up?

What time do you go to sleep? What time did you eat? What is your favourite time of day?

#### **Can you create your own shop at home?**

What would you sell? (toys, food- fruit and veg, books, art work) label your items and ask your grown up to use some coins and pretend to be a shop keeper. Practice adding up the prices and counting the money.

#### **What can you find in your garden?**

**What animal would you like to find in your garden? Can you write an invitation to invite it to a tea party?** What animal is it? Where is the party? What are you going to do? What will you eat and drink? What questions would you want to ask it?

Remember to use the right punctuation, conjunctions and adjectives!

### Science - How are animals different?

This term we will be learning all about animals and the similarities and differences between them.

#### **Can you create a fact file about your favourite animal?**

Draw a picture of them! Where do they live/what is their habitat? What do they eat? What do they look like? What makes them unique – tell us a fun fact about it!
